Better finances is our first priority.

Haugesund is in a difficult economic situation. Expenditures have been larger than income for years, and the deficit has grown considerably the last four years.

This can not go on, and it is important that we manage to get our finances in order in the next four years. A healthy economy is crucial in order to develop better services for our citizens.

Balancing the budgets and bringing expenditures under control is necessary if we want to be able to deliver on other promises.

Venstre proposes:

- a review of the organisation of the municipality in order to get a more effective organisation
- better financial control systems
- to postpone major investments until the deficit is reduced
- to increase payments of debt to reduce interest costs
- to review the necessity of all investments and prioritize education and welfare

Good services require a healthy economy.

Venstre will continue to fight against the proposed four lane road in Karmsundsgata!

We need better bus services, better bike lanes and better infrastructure for pedestrians, rather than more roads for cars.

What happens to Karmsundsgata also affects how we develop the central part of Haugesund.

We will not divide the town centre with a four lane road, instead we propose a solution where through traffic is diverted to go outside the town center.
